1. In 2011 in England and Wales, Bristol has the highest percentage of White people.
Westminster 61.6% Birmingham 57.9% **Bristol 84.0%** Leicester 50.6%

2. In 2011 in England and Wales, Leicester has the highest percentage of Asian/Asian British people.
Westminster 14.6% Birmingham 26.6% Bradford 26.8% **Leicester 37.1%**
3. In 2012 in England and Wales, Bradford has the highest percentage of Pakistani people.
Westminster 1.1% Birmingham 13.5% **Bradford 20.4%** Leicester 2.4%
4. In England and Wales, Cambridge has the highest percentage of Chinese people.
Cambridge 3.6% Plymouth 0.5% Oxford 2.3% Coventry 1.2%
5. In England and Wales, Ashford has the highest percentage of 'gypsies or Irish travellers'.
Colchester 0.0% **Ashford 0.5%** Oxford 0.1% Cornwall 0.1%
6. In England and Wales, for the people who do not have English or Welsh as their main language approximately 140,000 do not speak English at all.
7. In England and Wales, for the people who do not have English as their main language the majority of people have Polish as their main language.
8. Point A represents Cornwall. The vertical axis is the percentage of people who own their house outright. This percentage in 2011 for:
Oxford = 24.0% **Cornwall = 40.0%** Westminster = 17.7% York = 33.9%
9. Point B represents Westminster.
The vertical axis is the percentage of people who were born abroad. This percentage in 2011 for:
Merthyr Tydfil = $1 - 95.5 = 0.5\%$ **Westminster = $1 - 46.7 = 53.3\%$**
Birmingham = $1 - 77.8 = 22.2\%$ Oxford = $1 - 71.5 = 28.5\%$
10. Pie chart B represents Cornwall.
PieChart A represents Slough.
Pie chart C represents Leicester.
Pie chart D represents Birmingham.
