

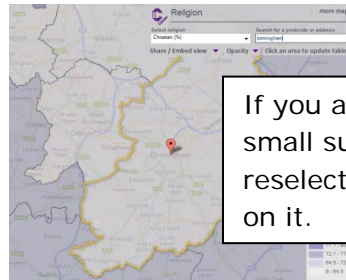

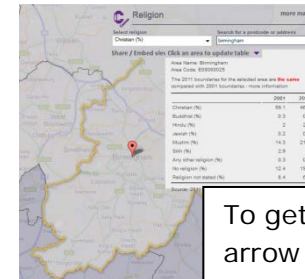

Check you are looking at the whole of the area by zooming out.



If you are only looking in a small subsection of an area reselect the area by clicking on it.



To get the data click on the arrow next to 'Click an area to update table'.

NB: To make this exercise more challenging the whole of the LONDON area combined (inner with outer) is not available on the maps. To match the cards for LONDON you will either need to estimate, use process of elimination (the only card left) or use the spreadsheet data. You need to decide which is most efficient in the time available.
