6. When they carried out the survey using this table the children found a problem. Think carefully - imagine you were carrying it out. What might the problem or problems be?
7. What would you need to do to find out which pet the class would least like to have?
8. Carry out a survey about pets in your class and draw a tally table and bar chart (block graph) of your results.
