



## How Old? – Starter Answers

The solutions to the card match activity are:

Tortoise	The oldest recorded lived to 152 years
Fox	In the wild don't make it to be 3 years old but if in captivity can live for about 10 years
Mayflies	Lifespan is usually less than a day
Mice	Rarely lives beyond 5 or 6 years
Queen Ant	Lives for up to 15 years until their sperm stocks are exhausted
Fish	Age is determined by growth rings in the ear
Humans	Oldest on record is 122 years old
Adult Stag Beetle	Lives for 3 to 4 months
Lobster	The only way you can gauge the age of this animal is by the size of it's shell
Lions	Capable hunters by the age of 2, become fully grown between 5 and 6 years and normally live about 13 years
Trees	Age is determined by growth rings
Gorilla	These animals never have babies after the age of 37
